

ABBOTT SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS and ELIGIBILITY

Named for Leon M. Abbott, Sovereign Grand Commander from 1921 to 1932, the Scholarship Program provides financial support for the continuing education of young men and women from Scottish Rite families and Masonic-related youth groups. Since 1951, more than \$3 million has been awarded to students from each state on the Northern Jurisdiction.

Eligibility:

- A currently enrolled freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior at an accredited college or university.
- A minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- A child of a Scottish Rite mason in the Northern Jurisdiction (or) a member of a youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity in the Northern Jurisdiction (DeMolay, Rainbow, Jobs Daughters).

Instructions:

- Review application completely and answer all questions;
- Upon filing, make sure all supporting documents are attached;
- Abbott Scholarship application and all Documentation must be submitted in duplicate;
- Make sure that the Official College Transcript (*not a computer generated copy*) from the College, University, or High School is submitted either with the application or is mailed directly from the University, College or High School to the Valley of Hartford Office;
- The FAFSA form can be secured from the Office of Financial Aid at any given College, University, or High School;
- The Scholarship Committee will NOT CONSIDER any incomplete or late application, or one that does not meet the required standards;
- High School applicants only: It is suggested that you also supply us with copy of the letter of acceptance to the College, or University, you plan to attend along with a copy of your reply letter;
- Make sure that you have signed the application;
- All applications must be received at the Scottish Rite Valley of Hartford Office, with all required documentation, <u>no later than March 31st.</u>
