

VALLEY SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS and ELIGIBILITY

The Valley of Hartford Scholarship Program provides financial support for the continuing education of young men and women from Scottish Rite families and Masonic-related youth groups who are not eligible to apply for or were not awarded the ABBOTT SCHOLARSHIP.

Eligibility:

- A currently enrolled freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior at an accredited college or university.
- A minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- A child of a Scottish Rite mason in the Northern Jurisdiction (or) a member of a youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity in the Northern Jurisdiction (DeMolay, Rainbow, Jobs Daughters).

Instructions:

- Review application completely and answer all questions;
- Upon filing, make sure all supporting documents are attached;
- Make sure that the Official College Transcript (*not a computer generated copy*) from the College, University, or High School is submitted either with the application or is mailed directly from the University, College or High School to the Valley of Hartford Office;
- The FAFSA form can be secured from the Office of Financial Aid at any given College, University, or High School;
- The Scholarship Committee will NOT CONSIDER any incomplete, late application, or one that does not meet the required standards;
- High School applicants only: It is suggested that you also supply us with copy of the letter of acceptance to the College, or University, you plan to attend along with a copy of your reply letter;
- Make sure that you have signed the application;
- All applications must be received at the Scottish Rite Valley of Hartford Office, with all required documentation, **no later than March 31st.**
